

Families Can Be Different




Look at the pictures. Read the statement. If the picture shows a family, circle it. If it does not show a family, underline it.

CONVERSATION

God Created People

GENESIS 2:4-24

God had the world ready for people. He took dust from the ground. He made a man out of the dust, but the man was not alive. God breathed into the nose of the man. The man became a living person! The man was Adam.

God made all kinds of trees in the garden. God made one tree called the tree of life. He made another tree, known as the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

God put Adam in the beautiful garden. God told Adam to care for the garden. God warned Adam, “You may eat from any tree in the garden, but do not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you do, you shall die.”

God also said, “It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a helper for him.”

God brought each kind of animal to Adam. Adam named the animals, but he did not find a helper from them.

God put Adam into a deep sleep. He took one of Adam’s ribs. He used the rib to make a woman. He brought the woman to the man.

“You will be called woman,” Adam said. He was very excited to see his new helper.
