



UNIT VERSE

Samuel in the Tabernacle

1 SAMUEL 1:24-28; 2:18-26; 3

Samuel's mother took him to live at the temple. She told the priest, "I stood here and prayed for a son. God gave me this boy. Now I give him to God."

Samuel lived and helped in the temple. Every year his mother brought him a new robe.

Priest Eli had sons who did not live in ways to honor God. Eli warned his sons to change, but they did not listen.

One night Samuel was lying down in the temple. He heard, "Samuel."

Samuel ran to Eli. He thought Eli called him. "Here I am," he said.

"I did not call," said Eli. "Go back and lie down."

Samuel went back. Again, he heard, "Samuel."

Samuel hurried to Eli. "Here I am."

Eli said, "I did not call you. Go back and lie down."

A third time, Samuel heard, "Samuel." He hurried to Eli. "Here I am," he said.

Now Eli knew God was calling Samuel. "Lie down. If you hear the voice again, say, 'Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening.'"

Samuel lay down. He heard "Samuel."

Samuel said, "Speak, Lord, for your servant is listening."

God told Samuel what was about to happen. Later Eli asked Samuel what God said. Samuel told Eli everything God said.

Samuel grew. God was pleased with him. All the people knew Samuel listened to God.



THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE
