

Paul Wrote to Timothy

ACTS 16:1-4; 2 TIMOTHY 1:1-5; 3:14-17

Paul preached about Jesus to Jews and Gentiles in many countries. Paul needed a helper. He heard about a disciple named Timothy who was from Lystra. People said good things about Timothy. Paul prepared Timothy to come with him. They traveled through many towns, preaching about Jesus and helping churches. Timothy was Paul's trusted friend and coworker.

Years later, Paul was in prison. It was near the end of his life when he wrote a letter to encourage Timothy. Timothy was now a young pastor.

"Dear Timothy, who I love as a son," the letter said. "I thank God for you every day and night when I pray. I want to see you so that I may be filled with joy."

In Paul's letter, he reminded Timothy that his mother Eunice and grandmother Lois taught Timothy to know about God since he was a child. Paul encouraged Timothy to continue to be strong in his faith. He told Timothy to keep telling others about Jesus. Paul also encouraged him to study the Scriptures because they would help Timothy know how to live. Paul told Timothy all Scripture was given by God. Paul helped Timothy to know how to live as a believer in Jesus Christ.
